### Summer at the Nasher

The Nasher Sculpture Center introduces a new **Summer Family Pass**, which offers **FREE ADMISSION** to the museum during the summer months, as well as Summer at the Nasher events. The \$35 Summer Family Pass is valid for 2 adults and children 18 and under in the same household, now through September 1, and is available for purchase at the Nasher Sculpture Center, Nasher Stores, and at DFW Tom Thumb stores. At the conclusion of Summer at the Nasher, Summer Family Pass holders may apply the cost of their pass to a new \$75 membership and receive 12 months of membership for just \$40.

**Free Films on First Thursdays** brings to the Nasher movie screen the best novels turned films ranked by AFI including *Jaws* on July 2, and *The Grapes of Wrath* on August 6. Enjoy a night out with **Friday Night Films in the Garden**, offered now through July 17. Upcoming screenings include *Top Gun* on July 3, *You've Got Mail* on July 10, and *My Big Fat Greek Wedding* on July 17. Families will enjoy the monthly **Target First Saturdays** event, which features a different "Big Idea" theme explored through art activities, scavenger hunts, and more. In the evening, **Saturday Night in the City** from 6 to 11pm features concerts in the Garden by popular Dallas bands and al fresco dining under the stars at Nasher Cafe. For those looking for an enjoyable lunch or early afternoon out during the week, **Summer at the Cafe** gives free admission for cafe patrons from 11am to 1pm, Tuesday through Friday. Guests can relax with a cool glass of freshly made lemonade or iced tea, and taste signature Wolfgang Puck dishes while overlooking the beautiful Sculpture Garden.
